The winner secures a ticket to the Regional Final in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia going to be held on 15th of February 2016. The winners of the first four battles - The Bridge, Drisa, My Doctor, and FFP faced against each other in the final battle. The tensions was high during this battle, even the jury deliberated needed extra time to choose a winner. In the end Food for People (FFP) was selected as the winner. 


DIU students formed human chain to raise the Voice for the Elimination of Violence against Women


